



Guide for Members of Overseas Reciprocal Clubs

Please read this information carefully and if you have any queries, please contact the Marylebone Cricket Club at reciprocalclubs@mcc.org.uk or by telephone to +44 207 616 8609. A list of matches at Lord's in 2018 is attached.

Eligibility

A Member of a Reciprocal Club may obtain a Reciprocal Guest pass, limited to a single four-week period, free of charge, provided that they meet the following criteria:

- They are a full voting Member;
- They are over 16;
- They do not work or maintain a residential address in the United Kingdom.

Please attach a copy of your Full membership card, Letter of Introduction from your Club, and identification confirming your residency outside the United Kingdom.

Entitlements for Major Matches

Pass: Eligible Members of Reciprocal Clubs are entitled to a Reciprocal Guest Pass, limited to a single four-week period, free of charge, which provides the holder with complimentary entry to the Ground, Pavilion and unreserved seating in the Members' Friends' Enclosures for the following match days at Lord's. Please note that the four-week period does not extend to both Test Matches.

- England v. Pakistan Test Match Days 3-5 – Saturday 26th, Sunday 27th and Monday 28th May 2018
- The Royal London One-Day Cup Final –Saturday 30th June 2018;
- Middlesex Twenty20 Cup matches;
- England v. India Test Match Days 4-5 – Sunday 12th and Monday 13th August 2018.

Tickets: Subject to availability, tickets for major matches can be pre-purchased by completing the form included. Rover tickets admit relatives or friends to unreserved seats in the Members' Friends' Enclosures, but not the Pavilion.

Please note: all applications for a Reciprocal Guest Pass which include any of the Major Match days listed above must be received at least 7 days before the match begins. Failure to do so will result in access to the ground being denied.

Entitlements for Matches at Lord's not listed above (Minor matches)

Pass: Please note that if prior application for a Reciprocal Guest Pass has not been received, admission to the Pavilion cannot be guaranteed.

Tickets: Subject to availability, ground admission tickets for guests for minor matches can be purchased from the Ticket Sales Window at the Ground.

Reciprocal Guest Pass holders will be able to introduce a guest into the Pavilion for minor matches, subject to meeting the dress regulations.

A confirmation of the request will be sent via email. This email will also include collection details for the Reciprocal Guest Pass and tickets. No tickets or passes will be sent out by post.

Please Note:

Reciprocal Guests are **not** permitted to purchase or wear M.C.C. colours.
